Govt. Degree College Kamalpur: At a Glance

Govt. Degree College Kamalpur, established in 1987, is affiliated to Tripura University (A Central University). It is a NAAC 'B' accredited premier institution of Higher Education in the aspirational Dhalai district of Tripura. The approximate 35 acres college campus possesses beautiful landscape with flowing Dhalai river at its eastern side with glimpse of peaks of Longtorai range. Kamalpur is connected to Agartala, capital of Tripura, by road via Ambassa (NH-44) and via Khowai (NH-208). Frequent bus services/auto-rickshaw services are available to the College from Kamalpur and Ambassa.

At present the College runs B.A and B.Sc. Programmes with enrollment of more than fifteen hundred students in the last academic session. Under extended education programme, N.C.C. and N.S.S. programmes are available in the College. Competent and responsible faculty members are the most prized assets of this institution. The University result, participation in games and sports, cultural activities and other co-curricular activities of our students need special mention.

- A) Starting of classes : By 10th July
- B) Duration of Semester (I/III/V) : July to December
- Sessional Exam. – I : In September
- Sessional Exam. – II : In November
- Semester End Exam. : By December 31
- C) Duration of Semester (II/IV/VI) : January to June
- Sessional Exam. – I : In February
- Sessional Exam. – II : In April
- Semester End Exam. : By June 30

N.B. The exact dates of the Sessional Exams will be fixed by the concerned Department of the College and that of Semester End Exam by the Controller of Exams, Tripura University.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission

1. Any student passing H.S. (+2)/equivalent examination with at least 4 subjects including English from any recognized Board/Council will be eligible for admission to the 1st Semester of the B.A./B.Sc. (Honours/General) programme, subject to the availability of seats.
2. No student will be allowed for admission in the 1st Semester course of studies after a lapse of 05(five) years from the year of passing of the previous qualifying examination.
3. A candidate opting for Honours in any subject must have to obtain (a) 40% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject in which she/he seeks Honours. OR (b) 35% in aggregate and 50% in the concerned subject in the H.S. (+2) examination. However selection of the student will depend on the availability of seats and their position in order of merit (based on aggregate of total marks obtained plus preferred subject for Honours)

4. Any one securing at least 50% marks in aggregate will be eligible for taking Honours in a subject which she/he did not study in H.S. (+2) or equivalent examination, subject to restriction of combination as per university rules.
5. A candidate who appeared but could not obtain pass marks in a particular subject in the H.S.(+2) examination will not be allowed to take that subject as an elective or Honours subject in the Degree Course. Honours will not be offered in a subject in which the candidate passed in Compartmental Exam.
6. No student will be allowed to pursue more than one regular programmes simultaneously offered by Tripura University.
7. A student will have to apply for University Registration in prescribed form within 30 days from last date of admission.
8. Reservation for SC/ST/PWD (with 40% and above disability) will be governed by the State Govt. reservation policy. i.e., 31% seats reserved for ST, 17% for SC and 3% for PWD.
9. The candidate who has passed in the previous years will not be given priority in merit list and will be treated as per norms.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. A student must pass all her/ his semester examinations within six years from the date of admission to the first semester course.
2. A student must wear College uniform and identity card within the College campus.
3. Students admitted in the College shall have to attend 75% of classes as per University Rules. Otherwise, her/his candidature will not be considered for final University examinations.
4. Ragging in any form is completely prohibited in the College campus and it is a punishable offence.
5. Students must submit a duly filled in declaration form related to anti-ragging commitment at the time of admission.
6. Sexual harassment in any form is strictly prohibited and a 'Committee for prevention of sexual harassment' chaired by the Principal is there to take note of any sort of complain.
7. The College expects good manners, discipline, and befitting decorum from the students in and outside the College.
